Faculty of Geography and History, *Praza da Universidade 1*

This neoclassical building was erected between 1769 and 1805 on the site that had occupied the College of Compañía de Jesús.

The top floor was added at the end of 19th century. Since 1974 this building has housed the Faculty of Geography and History of the Universidade de Santiago.

Inside the building are the cloister garden with fountain, the auditorium (*Paraninfo*) with paintings of Fenolera and Gonzalez, and the reading room as well as the terraces overlooking the entire city.

Situated in Santiago de Compostela and conceived as a large-scale cultural hub, devoted to the knowledge and creativity of today, the City of Culture of Galicia has been designed ever since its inception as an instrument to combine past and present, enabling an integrated approach to a strategic element for the development of Galicia: that of culture.

After ten years of intensive, rich discussions and a careful building process, the City of Culture of Galicia has been a project that makes architecture be at the service of culture and art.



The Museum has 6.600 square metres for exhibitions divided into three plants to host temporary exhibitions of profound importance and installations that due to their size could not be exhibited in other cultural centres of Galicia.

Culture, in its wider inclusive conception, will be the protagonist of this space that will integrate all the artistic, humanistic, creative demonstrations. Always in cooperation with the cultural framework and within the museum network of Galicia, in order to settle synergies and tight bonds with international entities to face projects of joint production and to enable all kind of exchanges that reinforce the global bonds of our culture.
