- Lublin is a scenic city in the East of Poland, boasting a historic old town with beautiful Renaissance townhouses, churches, mysterious alleys, vibrant pubs and restaurants. Walk with licensed guide along the route: Lithuanian Square, promenade Krakowskie Przedmieście, Market Square, Crown Tribunal, Grodzka Street, Lublin Castle, Archcathedral, Dominican Abbey.

- **Day 1**
Transfer to Cracow - the former Polish capital. Walking tour of Cracow's Old Town: the Wawel Royal Castle - seat of Poland's kings from the 11th to the early 17th century, The Royal Cathedral, Main Square - Europe's largest medieval town square, Hall building, St Mary's Basilica, Florian Gate. Dinner. Hotel accommodation. Overnight stay in hotel.
- **Day 2**
Breakfast. Visit to the Salt Mines of Wieliczka, placed on the UNESCO list of World Heritage Sites, the most eagerly visited tourist sites in Poland. Walking the tourist route through underground chapels, caverns and caves where you can admire sculptures and chandeliers made from salt crystals. Return to Lublin.

09:00-10:00 – transfer from Lublin to Puławy

10:00-11:30 – walk around Czartoryski park complex and visit in the palace museum

11:30-12:00 – transfer from Puławy to Kazimierz Dolny

12:00-14:30 – **Kazimierz Dolny sightseeing:** the Vistula promenade, Market Square, parish church with the oldest organs in Poland (built in 1620), ruins of the castle and defensive Tower, vantage point at Hill of Three Crosses, former Jewish District with old synagogue, famous local bakery (possible purchase of bread roosters)

14:30-16:00 – meal and shopping break (restaurants, pubs and shops are located around the Market Square)

16:00-16:30 – walk to the Vistula harbour

16:30-17:30 – ship cruise upstream of the Vistula River Gorge

17:30-18:30 – walk to the bus and transfer from Kazimierz Dolny to Nałęczów

18:30-19:15 – walk around the resort garden

19:15-20:00 – transfer from Nałęczów to Lublin

15:30-18:30 – **Zamość sightseeing (part 2)**: renaissance synagogue, walk through preserved parts of the fortress complex at the 7th bastion
