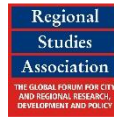

## Abstract Submission Guidelines

Please note that you must register for the Regional Studies Association Conference in order to submit an abstract. The conference is inclusive, which means that all submitted abstracts will be accepted. The exception to this is if the abstract contains inappropriate content, or falls outside of the topical themes of the conference.

Up to two abstracts may be submitted per registration, presentation of more than one paper depending on programme slots availability. Alternatively, a co-author on that paper may register and present.

The submitting author will be considered as the leading and presenting author, unless otherwise stated. If the co-authors are not cited when submitting the abstract, then their names will not appear in the conference volume. It is not sufficient to add additional author names to the abstract or full paper.

The following guidelines set out the acceptable format for abstract submission. These guidelines apply for our Central and Eastern Conference in Lublin, Poland, 11<sup>th</sup> – 13<sup>th</sup> September 2019.

Please note that the abstract submission closing date is 21<sup>st</sup> May 2019.

Abstracts guidelines:

- 250 words in length;
- Titled;
- Text only; no diagrams, graphs, pictures, citations or maps;
- All contributing authors must be named when submitting the paper via the online registration portal, with their country and institution, otherwise they may not appear in the conference volume. If you have problems with this, please contact the office;
- Indicate which theme the paper is being submitted under.

The Regional Studies Association reserves the right to reject abstracts that do not conform to the above criteria, or that fall out of the scope of relevant gateway themes. Please refer to the call for papers for relevant themes.
