

Post Conference Tours

The local organisers have organised 4 technical tours which will take place at the end of the conference on Friday 7th June. These tours will offer a wide range of perspectives and academic discussions.

Option 1, María José Piñeira and Rubén C. Lois: The historic centre of the city – This tour will look at urban regeneration, heritagization and touristification of the old quarter; the implementation of the new buildings in the historic city (e.g. [CGAC](#), [Ánxel Casal Library](#))

Option 2, Miguel Pazos and Lucrezia Lopez: San Pedro neighbourhood – The controversies between the neighbours and the tourists; the urban transformations caused by the (re)invention of the Way of Saint James in the city; a gentrification process?

Option 3, Francisco Durán and Ángeles Piñeiro: University heritage buildings – which tourism use? How to manage the issues regarding the balance between students' and academic life, on the one hand, and tourists, on the other?

Option 4, Valerià Paül and Juan Manuel Trillo: Green infrastructure and the particular development of the notion of greenbelt in Santiago. The conflicts regarding several urban parks, especially in the Sar River environs, and the relationship of the city with its rural fringe.

We are also offering two post conference tourist visits on Saturday 8th June, you can also sign up for these at the same time as the conference.

Option 1: After breakfast at your conference hotel in Santiago de Compostela, transfer to the area of Belesar in the Ribeira Sacra where you will visit a winery and a guided tasting will be held. Lunch in a restaurant overlooking the river Sil and the vineyards. After lunch, take a catamaran ride on the river (2 hours approximately). Return to Santiago de Compostela. £120

Option 2: After breakfast at your conference hotel in Santiago de Compostela, transfer to Porto. The day in Porto will start with a guided tour of the city. You will then visit a winery and taste the typical wines of the area. Lunch at a local restaurant. In the afternoon the group will have free time to explore the city. Dinner at a local restaurant for the whole group. 1 night in a hotel in Porto with breakfast. After breakfast transfer back to Santiago de Compostela. £155
